| <b>February 26 –<br/>March 16</b>  | Middle School Counselors present registration information to 8 <sup>th</sup> grade students and work on 4 year graduation plans.                  |
| <b>March 6 –<br/>April 23</b>      | Rising 9 <sup>th</sup> graders enter course selections into SAM at their middle school.   |
| <b>April 23</b>                    | All rising 9 <sup>th</sup> grade registration due into SAM.   |
| <b>May 1</b>                       | Rising 9 <sup>th</sup> grade Graduation Plans are turned in to 8 <sup>th</sup> grade counselors. Middle schools will forward to the high schools. |
