### ❖ **Support Services:**

- **Consultation** is available for independent students who need minimal, indirect support
- **Curriculum Assistance**
- **Introduction to Communication Skills** provides reading support
- **Resource Math**
- **In-class Resource (ICR)** provides support of both a regular educator and a special educator in the regular setting.
  - Refer to the Curriculum Guide for ICR offerings.
- **The Occupational Course of Study (OCS)** provides skills necessary for competitive employment opportunities.
  - It is a school-to-work program with a specific curriculum.
- **Certificate Programs** are available for students needing functional skills.
