I. Students are asked to provide information in **one** of the following formats...

This could include, but is not limited to, important character/personality traits, extracurricular passions accomplishments, the reason for pursuing a particular career//major, personal hardships, family dynamics, disabilities, etc. Examples that illustrate your points are always helpful.

B) You may answer the following questions. Please be as descriptive as possible.

1. What do you consider to be your outstanding accomplishments during the past three or four years?
2. In what areas have you shown the most development and growth during the past three or four years?
3. What do you consider to be your outstanding personality traits?
4. If you had to describe yourself in five adjectives, what would they be? Please include an example to illustrate each one.
5. Describe an activity (school, community, athletic, extracurricular) to which you have devoted extensive time and effort during the last two years. What do you think was gained from participation in this activity?
6. Describe a particular challenge or disappointment that you handled effectively.
7. Are there any other unusual circumstances, positive or negative, that have affected your educational or personal accomplishments? If so, please explain.
8. If you have ever been suspended, given detention, or gotten into trouble outside of school, please explain.
9. Please tell us anything else about yourself that you think we need to know in order to promote you as a college applicant.
